Maharashtra State Candidature :Type-A	Candidate Passing SSC & HSC from the State of Maharashtra.	A candidate who is Domicile of Maharashtra. (Candidate should have Domicile Certificate from the State of Maharashtra) OR Candidate should be born in Maharashtra State. (Candidate should have a Birth Certificate mentioning the Place of Birth which is in Maharashtra State.	Your candidature Type is Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature i.e. All India Candidature Type. Explanation: - (a) If candidate has not completed his/her SSC & HSC or Equivalent Qualifying Examination from the State of Maharashtra, then such candidates are not eligible for Maharashtra State Candidature Type-A though candidates are born in Maharashtra OR Candidate Possess the Domicile Certificate from the State of Maharashtra. They should fill the CAP Application form as an Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature i.e. All India Candidature Type. (b) If candidate has completed his/her SSC & HSC from the State of Maharashtra but are not born in Maharashtra OR does not have Domicile Certificate from the State of Maharashtra, such candidates are not eligible for Maharashtra State Candidature Type-A. Such candidates should fill the CAP Application form as an Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature i.e. All India Candidature Type. (c) If candidate has completed his/her SSC & HSC from the State of Maharashtra, and are not born in Maharashtra but candidate has a Domicile Certificate from the State of Maharashtra then such candidates are eligible for Maharashtra State Candidature type –A. They should fill CAP application form as Maharashtra State Candidature Type-A.

Explanation: - (a)If candidate has not completed his/her SSC & HSC or Equivalent Qualifying Examination from the State of Maharashtra, then such candidates are not eligible for Maharashtra State Candidature Type-B though Candidate's Father OR Mother Possess the Domicile Certificate from the State of Maharashtra. They should fill the CAP Application form as an Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature. i.e. All India Candidature Type. (b)If candidate has completed SSC & HSC from the State of Maharashtra & candidate does not possess domicile certificate from the state of Maharashtra or Birth Certificate from the State of Maharashtra but Candidate's Father or Mother Possess Domicile Certificate from the state of Maharashtra then such candidates are eligible for Maharashtra State Candidature Type-B. Such candidate should fill the CAP application form as a Maharashtra State Candidature Type-B.</p>
<p>Maharashtra State Candidature :Type-C</p>	<p>Candidate Passing SSC & HSC from the State of Maharashtra.</p>	<p>The Father or Mother of the Candidate is an employee of the Government of India or Government of India Undertaking who is posted and reported to duty in the Maharashtra State before the last date for submitting the Application Form for CAP.</p>	<p>Your candidature Type is Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature i.e. All India Candidature Type. Explanation: (a)If candidate has not completed his/her SSC & HSC or Equivalent Qualifying Examination from the State of Maharashtra, & though candidate's Father or Mother is an employee of the Govt. of India, then such candidate are not eligible for Maharashtra State Candidature Type-C. They should fill the CAP Application form as an Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature i.e. All India Candidature Type. (b) If candidate has completed his/her SSC & HSC or Equivalent Qualifying Examination from the State of Maharashtra, & Candidate's Father or Mother is an employee of the Govt. of India OR Government of India Undertaking who is posted and reported to duty in the Maharashtra State before the last date for submitting the Application Form for CAP, then such Candidates are eligible for Maharashtra State Candidature Type-C. They should fill the CAP Application form as a Maharashtra State Candidature Type-C.</p>
<p>Maharashtra State Candidature :Type-D</p>	<p>Candidate Passing SSC & HSC from the State of Maharashtra.</p>	<p>The Father or Mother of the Candidate is an employee of the Government of Maharashtra or Government of Maharashtra Undertaking.</p>	<p>Your candidature Type is Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature i.e. All India Candidature Type. Explanation: - (a)If candidate has not completed his/her SSC & HSC or Equivalent Qualifying Examination from the State of Maharashtra, & though Father or Mother of the Candidate is an employee of the Government of Maharashtra, then such candidate are not eligible for Maharashtra State Candidature Type-D. They should fill the CAP Application form as an Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature Type. i.e. All India Candidature Type. (b)If candidate has completed his/her SSC & HSC or Equivalent Qualifying Examination from the State of Maharashtra, & Father or Mother of the Candidate is an employee of the Government of Maharashtra or Government of Maharashtra Undertaking, then such candidates are eligible for Maharashtra State Candidature Type-D. They should fill the CAP Application form as a Maharashtra State Candidature Type-D.</p>

They should fill the CET Application form as an Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature Type. i.e. All India Candidature Type.

They should fill CAP application form as an Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature Type candidate. i.e. All India Candidature Type.</p> <p>B) Candidates who have completed their SSC and HSC or Equivalent qualifying examination from Out Side Maharashtra State but Born in Maharashtra & having a birth certificate issued by the Govt of Maharashtra or they possess domicile certificate from the Govt of Maharashtra State come under Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature Type. i.e. All India Candidature candidate. They should fill CAP application form as an Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature Type candidate i.e. All India Candidature Type.</p> <p>C) Candidates who have completed their SSC and HSC or Equivalent qualifying examination from the State of Maharashtra but they are not Born in Maharashtra & does not possess a birth certificate issued by the Govt of Maharashtra or they do not possess domicile certificate from the Govt of Maharashtra State come under Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature Type. i.e. All India Candidature candidate. They should fill CAP application form as an Out Side Maharashtra State Candidature Type candidate i.e. All India Candidature Type.</p>
